- The City of Highland and the surrounding community is ready, willing and capable of supporting a viable medical clinic and will provide assistance within its means to do so.
- Said city is aware of, and concerned by, the recent temporary closing of the HCH Highland Medical Clinic.
- Said city believes that the Highland Clinic provides quantitatively viable support for the operations of the Hiawatha Community Hospital.
- Said city would like an opportunity to provide input and support into any decisions to be made by the Hiawatha Hospital Board of Trustees and administration concerning the future operations of such clinic in order to help it reach its true potential.
