

ORDINANCE NUMBER 561

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, KANSAS, ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION TO BE RECEIVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND AND AMENDING PRIOR ORDINANCE NUMBER 555 OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Highland has the right and authority, by virtue of its home rule powers and Kansas statutory authority, to set and establish the compensation to be received by the employees of the City;

WHEREAS, the City believes that a monthly and/or hourly salary schedule should be established for the full-time position of Chief of Police/Marshal, which is both administrative and otherwise, setting forth a range of compensation, established in accordance with the various duties and qualifications of said position, and to be implemented in recognition of the experience, qualifications and performance of each individual employee filling the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: COMPENSATION OF CHIEF OF POLICE

SECTION 1: (C) of Ordinance Number 555 of said City shall be amended by adding the position of Chief of Police/Marshal, with a range of monthly compensation, as follows:

<u>POSITION</u>	<u>MONTHLY COMPENSATION</u>
Chief of Police/Marshal	\$2,500.00 to \$4,500.00

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF PRIOR ORDINANCE. Ordinance Number 555 of the City of Highland, Kansas is hereby amended as set forth above.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. The terms and provisions of this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately, subject to its summary publication in the official city newspaper in accordance with Kansas law.
